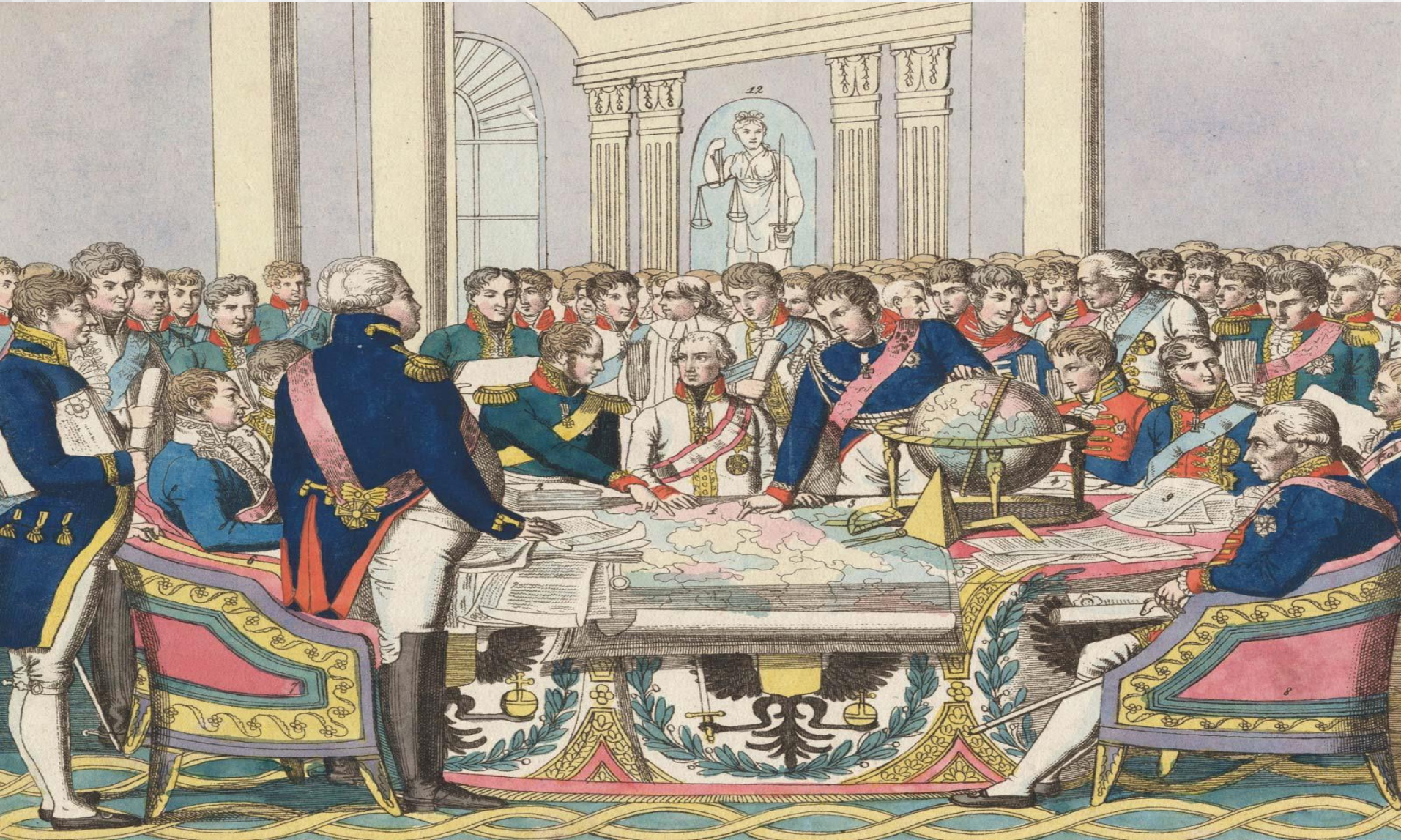

# Setting the Stage

---

- European heads of government were looking to establish long-lasting peace and stability on the continent after the defeat of Napoleon. They had a goal of the new European order – one of collective security and stability for the entire continent. A series of meetings in Vienna, Austria, known as the **Congress of Vienna** were called to set up policies to achieve this goal. Originally, the Congress of Vienna was scheduled to last for four weeks. Instead, it went on for eight months.
